HOW TO MAKE A DONATION

A donation can be made to SA Bridge at any time without reference to your will.

You may wish to make a monetary donation, either as a one-off amount, an ongoing yearly gift or as a prize for a particular event. The donation can be made in-confidence if desired.

To make a donation simply contact the General Manager who will provide you a form to complete.

BEQUESTS

WHAT IS A BEQUEST?

A bequest is a property or a sum of money committed to an organisation and donated upon the donor's death.

A bequest can take a variety of forms. Deciding which way you feel is the fairest method of dividing your estate will determine its format.

HOW TO MAKE A BEQUEST

If you are considering leaving a bequest to SA Bridge you should seek the advice of a solicitor who handles wills. It is also recommended that you consult a financial or tax advisor.

If you already have a will but would like to leave a gift to SA Bridge you can do so by making a simple addition to your existing will. This is called a codicil. We do suggest you see a solicitor if this is your intention.

If you do not have a will at the moment, you can simply include a bequest when you write a new will. Whatever your circumstances, we would advise you to see a solicitor to ensure your wishes are followed. With your permission, donations and bequests can be listed on our Club's website in perpetuity.

NATURE OF BEQUESTS

1. Gift of Whole Estate
2. Gift of Portion of Estate as a percentage
3. Bequest - Cash Amount
4. Bequest - House or Other Asset

Suggested wording in your will for these options is available from the General Manager.

While SA Bridge prefers that gifts be able to be used for its general purposes in order to meet its changing needs, if you wish your bequest to be used for a particular purpose the wording to satisfy this wish is also available from the General Manager.
