### **WELCOME**

Welcome to the South Australian Bridge Assoc. We expect our members will enjoy their bridge, our facilities, and the social atmosphere of our club in 2026.

We run regular walk-in bridge sessions, and special events across a number of venues across Adelaide. You can play bridge from Monday to Saturday every week, and there are also special monthly events usually on a Sunday. Our bar is open for members' enjoyment at the end of play after most sessions. We will have some special sessions on Monday nights and all members are encouraged to come along and try something different. We will be holding 'Venue Championships' for players who regularly play at one of our satellite venues.

We provide classes for beginners and for more experienced players, Supervised Play sessions, and pre-game tutorials before some sessions to assist our players to develop their bridge. We also hold a 2-hour 'short bridge' session on Monday at 2pm, for those members who have limited time available as this has proven to be quite popular.

Most sessions are walk-in pairs, which means that players can simply turn up and play with their partner, however, there are a few events where pre-registration is required. These are described in this program.

For our Supervised sessions, members are welcome to turn up on their own and we will try to arrange a partner for that session. For our regular sessions, members are expected to arrange their own partners, however if you are new to the club we will assist you in finding a partner. In addition, we will endeavour to find you a partner, if your scheduled partner is unavailable at short notice. Complete the *Find a Partner* form on the website if you need assistance.

All members are encouraged to use the Pre-pay system via Hello Club for their table fees, event registrations and course bookings. This is beneficial for the club as it means there is minimal cash handling. It is also a convenient and easy-to-use system for our members. Members make a deposit in advance and the account is debited when you play a session or book a course, the club will advise you when your account is getting low.

We hope that you enjoy your bridge in 2026. Please help your fellow members to enjoy their bridge as well by being friendly, welcoming and polite to partner and all players. If you have any queries or concerns, please contact the General Manager, the Director or Tutor of your session, or any member of the Management Committee.

### 2026 PROGRAM

#### 1. INTENSIVE BEGINNERS COURSE

Learn bridge in five days, choose between January or June intensive classes:

- Monday 5 January to Friday 9 January, 10.30am to 2.30pm each day
- Monday 1 June to Friday 5 June, 10.30am to 2.30pm each day

#### 2. GENERAL TEACHING PROGRAM

**Beginners' classes** are split into 2 sessions, each of 6 weeks. In the first 6-weeks, you will learn and consolidate the basics of bridge with the following 6-weeks introducing additional concepts to prepare you to play in the club-supervised sessions. At **Unley**, most sessions offer multiple sections to accommodate different levels of play. Thursday evening mostly has events run by our State Body, the SA Bridge Federation. These are run over a number of weeks and prior entry is required. Entry to SABF events can be made via My ABF (online platform).

Pre-session lectures are at 9.30am on Mondays and Tuesdays, 10am on Wednesdays and Thursdays, 1pm on Fridays and 12.30pm on Saturdays. Monday and Tuesday nights offer a pre-session lecture at 6:45pm. On the last Sunday of most months from February to November, we have a 'Pleasant Sunday' afternoon of bridge with shared afternoon tea post-session.

At **Walkerville**, Monday and Thursday have multiple sections. At **Payneham**, Friday morning has a relaxed single section session. **Glenelg North** and **Mt Barker** both have relaxed single section sessions.

### INFORMATION ABOUT PROGRAMMED COMPETITIONS

#### **PAIRS EVENTS**

The majority of sessions at Unley are graded (walk-in) duplicate match-pointed pairs, with competitions generally played over a calendar month.

**Graded or Ungraded Sections**: Graded sessions have between two and four grades, depending on the number of pairs playing and the spread in the standard of the players. Check with the Director if you're unsure which section to sit in.

**Monthly Eclectic Competition:** Unless otherwise stated in this program, monthly pairs competitions are eclectic. This means that if a pair plays in all the competition sessions, their worst score is dropped when calculating their aggregate score for the competition.

For a small number of events, shown in the program, the winners are to be the highest finishing A Grade pair.

**Masterpoint Awards**: For pairs events, session masterpoints are awarded to the top half of the field. Also, the overall winners and the top half of the field will receive additional masterpoints

#### OTHER TYPES OF EVENTS AT SA BRIDGE ASSOC.

As well as match point pairs, there are Teams and Butler Pairs events in the program, mainly on Thursday nights (SABF), but also on Wednesday mornings (SABF), and on Monday nights (SABA). These events require pre-nomination and representation at each session of the event for which you nominate. (This means you must attend each session yourself or find a substitute to send in your stead if you are unable to play in one or more sessions). If you are interested in trying one of these "different" events, talk to the General Manager, a Director or Tutor.

### Handicap Pairs

A prize is awarded to the pair with the best 'handicap' score for the month in the Tuesday night and Wednesday morning sessions respectively.

Winners must be present at the first Tuesday night or Wednesday morning session in the following month to collect their prize.

There is also a handicap pairs prize as part of the Jim May Pairs held on Friday afternoons in November.

### Australian Bridge Federation (ABF)

#### **ALERT and ANNOUNCING REGULATIONS**

Bridge is not a game of secrets - if you or your partner use a call that has an agreed meaning within your partnership then the opponents are entitled to know exactly what that bid means.

In the early days of bridge, alerts would have been unnecessary since everybody played a similar system. Even the emergence of new systems such as Acol, with its lower no trump range, wouldn't have been a problem - the opponents sat down, announced their system, and the auction would then be entirely apparent to both pairs.

In recent years a wide range of new bidding systems has emerged. Whilst calls such as  $1 \blacktriangle$  and  $1 \blacktriangledown$  are usually consistent in what they promise, there can be a wide range of meanings for the other opening calls.

Doubles have a particularly wide range of interpretations, with the possible meanings now including penalty, takeout, card-showing, responsive, or even a transfer to an unspecified suit!

To help ensure that the players are able to understand the opponent's bids, the ABF adopts an 'Alert' system. Simply put, if a bid has an unusual meaning, their partner says "Alert", and uses the Alert card if bidding boxes are being used. The opponents then know that they might need to ask about that bid.

There are also bids that are 'Self-Alerting'. These are bids where there is generally no common meaning, so players should expect to ask about them. If a self-alerting call has been made by an opponent, e.g. a double of your 1NT opening, then you should act as if the call has been alerted, and inquire of its meaning in the same manner as you would if an alert had been given.

You can ask about an alerted, or self-alerted, bid when it is your turn to bid. Explanations should be as complete as possible. If you become declarer you should offer to give a full explanation of your auction to the opponents if it contained any alerted (including self-alerted) calls, or calls they may not fully understand.

Before you start play, it is beneficial to check with your opponents:

Their basic system.

The strength and style of their 1NT openings.

Their carding agreements.

The opponents should also advise you of any unusual bids or carding methods before starting, this is referred to as 'pre-alerting'.

The ABF also requires 'Announcements'. This means that when you open 1C or 1NT your partner should 'announce' to your opponents what the bid is about. When you open 1NT, your partner should announce the strength range, e.g. "12-14" or "15-17" (or whatever the range is).

If you open 1C, your partner should automatically announce the essential meaning of the bid. For a natural system, the announcement is the minimum number of clubs, "4+ clubs" or "3+ clubs" or "2+ clubs". For Precision 1C openings, you would say "artificial, 16+ HCP". For other artificial systems, your partner announces "UNUSUAL" and the opponents can clarify.

Your opponents will still be able to ask questions, but the basics should have already been supplied.

### MASTERPOINT RANKINGS

Masterpoints won by players, over their lifetime, are used to determine each player's master ranking. There are currently 21 different ranks ranging from Graduate Master to Diamond Grand Master. Players receive an official certificate with each Scheme promotion. Masterpoint ranks may be used to determine seeding in tournaments. In addition, events are held that are restricted to players of a certain masterpoint ranking. This provides an opportunity for players to play others of a similar standard, particularly for those players who are new to bridge.

When a player earns a total of 1,000 masterpoints they become members of the One Thousand Club. There are no red or gold requirements.
